## **Hazardous Waste Management Policy**

Raise awareness and promote proper practices among university staff and students regarding hazardous waste handling.

### Disposable Item Use Minimization Policy

Promote the use of reusable products on campus. Increase awareness of the importance of consumption reduction and support sustainability awareness initiatives. Reduce the volume of waste generated from disposable items

## Plastic and Disposable Item Minimization Policy

Achieve an annual reduction in plastic consumption. Increase awareness among students, faculty, and staff about the risks of plastic pollution and the importance of adopting sustainable alternatives.

Encourage the use of recyclable materials in various university activities.

## Recycled Waste Management and Measurement Policy

Reduce the amount of waste generated at the university by improving resource efficiency.

Increase the percentage of recycled waste relative to the total waste generated.

Decrease waste sent to landfills in line with sustainability goals.
